Issues:

1. At around 8pm on 7/2/16, I noticed a fork truck operator not wearing his seatbelt. I stopped him and requested he wear it. Operator seemed indifferent, but complied with my request. No less than three more times over the course of the next few hours, I'd caught the operator again not wearing his seatbelt. On the fourth time, he did fasten his seatbelt as he saw me walking by.
 - a. 7/5/16 – Operator appears to be wearing seatbelt at all times
2. At ~7:15 pm on July 5th, 2016, I heard yelling and foul language from the parking lot. Upon looking out the 2nd-floor window, I witnessed a female employee being attacked by three males and one female. I went outside to discover that the 4 aggressors did not work here. The female victim retreated into the plant. The female aggressor then threatened me with a Taser. I backed away and stepped into my car and out of the effective reach of the Taser, and called 911. The 4 aggressors then fled to their vehicle, which was parked on the service drive near the gate, and I followed them out to the main road. I then returned to the plant, and the Ann Arbor Police arrived shortly thereafter.
