<p>NATURE: Informational report</p> <p>LOCATION: University of Michigan Diagonal 920 North University Ave Ann Arbor, MI 48109</p> <p>REPORT RECEIVED: On 03/16/2017 I was a fully uniformed police officer with the University of Michigan Police Department assigned to the Adam patrol area. While on patrol I was dispatched to the Diagonal side of Hatcher Library by request of the Ann Arbor Police Department. Ann Arbor Police Officers had been involved in a foot pursuit of a subject known to have a felony warrant out of their department.</p> <p>OFFICER ACTIONS: I arrived on the Diagonal and made contact with Ann Arbor Police Sergeant Strange #305 who asked that I provided a property damage crash report involving one of their marked police vehicles. I observed Ann Arbor Police Vehicle #346 parked at the center of the Diagonal with significant damage sustained to the passenger side front bumper. I also observed a aluminum light pole (C12S016) lying on the ground and partially underneath the vehicle near the passenger side rear tire.</p> <p>DESCRIPTION OF EVENTS: On 03/16/2017 Ann Arbor Police Officer, Roman Morrow #006 was driving fully marked police vehicle #346 south east from Mason Drive toward the center of the Diagonal when he struck a pathway light pole. Officer Morrow was involved in an attempt to apprehend</p>



first observed by officers at the Panera Bread located at (777 North University). fled on foot toward Mason drive and AAPD officers followed him in their vehicles. Some of the AAPD officers exited their vehicles on Mason Drive and a foot pursuit began toward Hatcher Library. Officer Morrow #346 continued in his vehicle along the pedestrian walk way (south east) toward the center of the Diagonal to supplement the foot pursuit. While proceeding on the walkway, toward the center of the Diagonal, the officer drove his vehicle off of the paved path and onto the adjacent grassy area to avoid pedestrians. The grassy area was partially covered with snow, loose soil and standing water, causing the vehicle to partially lose traction. Officer Morrow #346 momentary lost control of the vehicle and it collided with a University of Michigan light pole along the west side of the pathway. The police vehicle continued driving approximately 30 yards onto the brick paved portion of the Diagonal's center. The pole did become lodged under the police vehicle and was dragged along as the vehicle continued forward. The suspect, was subsequently apprehended by AAPD Officers on the steps of Hatcher Library for the outstanding felony warrant. AAPD Police Vehicle #346 did sustain significant damage to the passenger side front corner. I received no reports of injuries related to the crash.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

I completed a State UD-10, off roadway property damage crash report that will be turned over to the on duty Ann Arbor Police Sergeant.
