To Whom It May Concern:

Please be advised that this office has been retained to represent individuals and all others similarly situated to assert claims related to the City of Ann Arbor and its involvement to assess parking fines and late fines in unlawful and unauthorized amounts. Hundreds of thousands of dollars in unlawful and unauthorized fines have been assessed and collected by the City of Ann Arbor to the detriment of thousands of car owners (if not more) who overpaid parking fines assessed by the City of Ann Arbor.

A FOIA request was made to the City of Ann Arbor which requested information regarding overpayments made on parking violations and/or moving violations from January 1, 2012 to October 23, 2019, issued by the City and/or the University of Michigan that have not been refunded to the alleged violator. In response, a 92-page document was produced which reported an approximate total of 2,644 individuals that received parking citations from the City of Ann Arbor, made overpayments in excess of the fines, and were never refunded the amount of said overpayment.

My client and all others similarly situated have been damaged monetarily and suffered constitutional violations as a result of the City of Ann Arbor's improper conduct in collecting hundreds of thousands of dollars in fines to which it was not legally entitled. 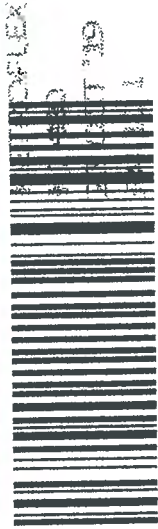
