Dear Mr. Dohoney Jr.

Washtenaw County wishes to amend the contract with your agency. Corporation Counsel has indicated that this amendment could be accomplished by a letter signed by both of us. If this amendment is agreeable to you, please sign and return all copies of this letter. You will receive an executed copy of this letter upon completion.

Accordingly, I hereby amend the Service Contract between Washtenaw County and City of Ann Arbor dated March 1, 2012 and amended on July 27, 2017 as follows:

Amend ARTICLE I – TERM to extend the contract as follows:

"This contract shall be in full force and effect for the term of four months commencing March 1, 2022, terminating on June 30, 2022."

The following fees/services will no longer be in effect:

Amend ARTICLE III - Charge for Services

Cost to the City of Ann Arbor for Metro Dispatch services will continue at the current rate of \$65,155.16 per month for each month of this extension.

- B. In exchange for allowing the COUNTY to utilize the square footage in the City's Fire Station One, 2nd Floor (previously used by the City's 911 Dispatch Center) to provide these services, this payment will be offset by the amount of \$12,895.60 per year, for any year in which the COUNTY utilizes the square footage in the City's Fire Station One, 2nd Floor as its County Dispatch Station
- C. Payment to be made in four installment (1 each quarter) within thirty calendar days of the date of receipt of COUNTY quarterly invoice. Such invoices will reflect the pro-rata offset specified in in subparagraph B above.

Payment for square footage in the City's Fire Station One, 2nd Floor is no longer required as of March 1, 2022 since Metro Dispatch has moved their operations and staff to a new facility.

APPENDIX A SERVICE LEVEL SPECIFICATIONS

Dispatch of police and community standards calls for service.

This service will continue however Metro Dispatch will no longer determine parking ticket and towing status for the CITY or the University of Michigan Division of Public Safety & Security. Nor maintain log in or user accounts for Complus or any other parking related system.

Perform associated tasks to support automated alarm enforcement billing being conducted by a third party (EnablePoint).

This software is no longer in use by Metro Dispatch. Ann Arbor is acquiring the necessary data through the CLEMIS CAD system.

Furnish all of the materials and labor necessary to take and dispatch the CITY'S police emergency calls and City CODE RED emergency system calls pursuant to protocols agreed to by the CITY. CODE RED is no longer utilized by the City and therefore this service will no longer be provided by the COUNTY.

All other terms and conditions remain the same as in the original contract, subsequent amendments and any applicable RFP/RFQ.

Resolution to Approve a Four Month Extension of the Contract with Washtenaw County for Police Dispatch Services (\$260,620.64)

This resolution approves a four-month extension of the existing contract for services with Washtenaw County for the provision of City-wide dispatch services for law enforcement personnel.

The current contract expires on February 28, 2022. This four-month extension is requested so that Washtenaw County and the City may continue to negotiate a longer-term contract for police dispatch services.

<u>Budget/Fiscal Impact</u>: The extension of this contract shall be at the current rate of \$65,155.16 per month (\$260,620.64 total for four months) currently being paid for police dispatch services. This has been budgeted in the FY22 Police Department General Fund budget.

Whereas, The City currently utilizes the police dispatch services of Washtenaw County for their dispatching needs;

Whereas, The City recommends an extension of the existing contract so that further contract negotiations may occur without the contract expiring; and

Whereas, The funding for the contract extension is in the FY22 Police Department General Fund budget;

RESOLVED, That City Council approve a contract with Washtenaw County for an extension of the contract for police dispatch services for the City of Ann Arbor;

RESOLVED, That the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized and directed to execute the contract for services after approval as to substance by the City Administrator and approval as to form by the City Attorney; and

RESOLVED, That the City Administrator be authorized to take all necessary actions to implement this resolution.
