The Department of State (Department) is in receipt of your email, submitted in response to the Department's November 18, 2025 determination that there may be reason to believe that you violated the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (MCFA or Act).

In your email, you included a statement of organization for a ballot question committee "Respect Ann Arbor Parks" created by your client Library Green Conservancy. Additionally, you included campaign statements filed by Respect Ann Arbor Parks and receipt from Washtenaw County indicating that you client has paid a \$2,300 late filing fee for those reports. All of the reports have been accepted by Washtenaw County and are available public review on their website.

Given this, the Department concludes that a formal warning is a sufficient resolution to the complaint and considers the matter concluded. Thank you for your prompt resolution of this matter.
